



RON STAGG MATCH PLAY FORMAT

Handicaps

This is a handicapped Match Play event.

Play is conducted on the **handicap each player has on the day** they play each other.

The lowest handicapped player plays of scratch. The scratch player then concedes the difference in strokes between their handicaps to their opponent.

For Example:- player A is off a handicap of 10; player B is off a handicap of 21.

The stroke difference is 11.

This means player A gives player B 11 strokes. This gives player B an extra stroke over player A on the holes rated **1 to 11** as presented in the index on the score card.

The **full difference** in handicaps is to apply.

Competition Completion Dates

Rounds are to be completed on, or before the due date as set out in the clubhouse, or as set out in the club syllabus.
